✓ **Bread, rice and dairy**



✓ **Compostable liners**
(check for the seedling logo)

No packaging

GREAT Sorts do better than the bin by:

- **G**ifting unwanted items in good condition
- **R**ecycling paper, cardboard, cans, plastic and glass
- **E**arth-cycling food scraps into compost
- **A**voiding single-use items by choosing better, reusable alternatives
- **T**aking batteries, e-waste and chemicals to local drop-off points



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
